• The name itself is from *kalagan* (literally "[strong] spirited") which means "fierce" or "brave"; from *kalag* ("spirit" or "soul") in the native animistic anito religions. Hence, the whole Provincia de Caraga of AD 1622 was called *region de gente animosa*, that is "region of spirited men". **Caraga** is famous for its cultural heritage. It has vast natural attractions that guarantee unparalleled adventures.

• The presence or the absence of metallic deposits in an area is sometimes caused by type of the soil and the ever-changing temperature and pressure in the land that may cause the formation of some metals such as gold, silver and copper and other metallic deposits.

Region XIII or the Caraga Administrative Region (known as **Caraga**) was created under Republic Act No. 7901 approved on February 23, 1995. It consists of the provinces of Agusan del Norte, Agusan del Sur, Surigao del Norte and Surigao del Sur. Its cities are Bayugan, Bislig, Butuan, Cabadbaran, Surigao and Tandag. Republic Act No. 9355 An Act Creating the Province of Dinagat Islands, as the 5th province of Caraga separated from the mother province Surigao del Norte.
