Invitation

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), RSSO XIII in coordination with the Regional Statistics Committee (RSC) Caraga will be holding the **2nd Caraga Statistics Congress and Data Festival (2CSCDF)** on **19 October 2021**. This will be a hybrid/blended activity, engaging both the virtual and face-to-face mode. Aside from the paper presentations, we are inviting college students from State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) of Caraga as well as its residents to join the statistical games.

About the Statistical Games

The 2CSCDF, organized and spearheaded by PSA RSSO XIII in coordination with RSC Caraga, is the second congress and data festival which started in 2018. It aims to:

- 1) provide an avenue for data analysts, statisticians, planning officers and data users to meet together;
- 2) promote a culture of excellence among data managers through sharing and exchange of data management practices and developments; and
- 3) elicit the cooperation and support of statisticians and professionals in related fields from the government, academe and private sector towards a more responsive statistical system.

The event will be conducted during the 32nd National Statistics Month (NSM) celebration in October 2021. This year, the 2CSCDF will feature plenary sessions, invited/contributed paper sessions, poster sessions, statistical exhibit, and statistical games for college students.

There will be three (3) different statistical games to be played before and during the big event which will be participated by students and/or residents of Caraga as follows:

- 1) Promotional Video on Data Revolution:

Data revolution is an explosion in the volume and production of data matched by a growing demand for data from all parts of society (www.statistics.gov.rw). It creates unique possibilities for governments and the public sector to inform and transform the society while giving outcomes on positive social impact.

Promotional video, on the other hand, is used to express the purpose in promoting and appreciating the data revolution. The content of the video must be digestible and light but informs efficiently the viewers on the message. It will also help to get attention and interest of the viewers.

- 2) Facebook Stat Go:

The game is derived from the virtual activities conducted in response to pandemic. It utilizes the facebook platform since it accommodates interaction among users. Thus, enabling FB users to connect and maximize its capability. The FB Stat Go is aimed at promoting the significance and relevance of statistics in life.

- 3) NSM TikTok Challenge:

The NSM TikTok Challenge uses the TikTok apps to create short videos that will feature and promote the NSM jingle.
