Parents or guardians of the registrants are advised to bring the following documents as proof of the child's identity:

- 1. Original Birth Certificate of the child or valid ID which contains their front-facing photograph, full name, birthday, and signature
- 2. School ID of the child for the current year

Further, the public is reminded to bring with them their vaccination cards/ quarantine pass/ emergency pass as maybe required by the concerned LGU and to strictly observe safety protocols inside and outside the registration center.
