





Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities First Phase of June 2025 Butuan City

1. Rice, Well Milled


At the city level, a kilogram of well-milled rice had an average retail price of PhP 48.94 in the first phase of June 2025 (01 to 05 June 2025). This was higher than the average retail prices of Php 48.49 per kilogram during the first phase of May 2025 (01 to 05 May 2025) and PhP 48.04 per kilogram in the second phase of May 2025 (15 to 17 May 2025). 2. Pork, Meat with Bones



An average retail price of pork, meat with bones was at PhP 320.50 per kilogram at the city level during the first phase of June 2025. This showed an increase from its average retail prices of Php 309.67 per kilogram in the second phase of May 2025 and Php 303.83 per kilogram during the first phase of May 2025. (Figure 2)

3. Bangus

Figure 3: Average Retail Price per Kilogram of Bangus Butuan City: First Phase and Second Phase of May 2025 and First Phase of June 2025



A kilogram of bangus in the city had an average retail price of PhP 232.83 during the first phase of June 2025. This was lower than its average retail price of PhP 234.50 per kilogram in the second phase and the first phase of May 2025. (Figure 3)

4. Pechay, Native

Figure 4: Average Retail Price per Kilogram of Pechay, Native Butuan City: First Phase and Second Phase of May 2025 and First Phase of June 2025



A kilogram of native pechay in the city had an average retail price of PhP 134.00 during the first phase of June 2025. This showed an increase from its average retail price of PhP 109.17 in the second phase of May 2025. Similarly, this was higher relative to its price level in the first phase of May 2025 of PhP 113.33 per kilogram. (Figure 4)

5. Onion, Red

Figure 5: Average Retail Price per Kilogram of Onion, Red Butuan City: First Phase and Second Phase of May 2025 and First Phase of June 2025



A kilogram of red onion in the city had an average retail price of PhP 191.67 during the first phase of June 2025. This selected commodity also recorded continued increase from its average retail price of PhP 162.50 per kilogram in the first phase of May 2025, then PhP 167.50 per kilogram in the second phase of May 2025. (Figure 5)

6. Banana, Latundan



A kilogram of banana, latundan in the city had an average retail price of PhP 65.00 during the first phase of June 2025, higher than its average retail price of PhP 68.00 per kilogram in the second phase of May 2025. Likewise, this registered an increase relative to its price level in the first phase of May 2025 at PhP 69.00 per kilogram. (Figure 6)

7. Cooking Oil

A liter of cooking oil in the city had an average retail price of PhP 216.45 during the first phase of June 2025. This was higher relative to its average retail prices of PhP 210.10 per liter in the second phase of May 2025 and PhP 211.44 per liter in the first phase of May 2025. (Figure 7)
