**9 May 2024, La Paz, Agusan del Sur** – The Provincial Statistical Office of Agusan del Sur proudly announces a significant milestone achieved in its ongoing efforts to ensure accurate birth registration within the province. On May 9, 2024, the office hosted an awarding ceremony for the issuance of Certificate of Live Births in Security Paper (SECPA) under the Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP) in the Municipality of La Paz, Agusan del Sur.

The ceremony, which took place during the Government on Wheels initiative in Barangay Lydia, marked a crucial step forward in enhancing birth registration services for residents in the province. By facilitating the issuance of SECPAs, the Provincial Statistics Office aims to provide citizens with secure and authenticated birth certificates, essential for various legal and administrative purposes.
