Veruela National High School Claims Victory during the Division- Level Inter- High School Statistics Quiz

The division-level Inter-High School Statistics Quiz convened junior high school students from across DepEd Agusan del Sur Division on October 28, at the Division Training Center. This event aims to foster statistical literacy and promote the use of data among young minds, with participation from 13 schools across the Division. Students from Binucayan, Veruela, Santa Josefa, Sta. Irene, San Luis, Bunawan, Panagangan, Novele, Del Monte, San Toribio, Padiay, Buena Suerte, and Pulang-Lupa National High School (NHS) represented their schools in a series of competitive rounds.



Contestants from various schools in the DepEd Agusan del Sur Division raised their answers on flashcards during the Inter-High School Statistics Quiz held on October 28, 2024, at the Division Training Center in Patin-ay, Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur.

The quiz tested participants' foundational knowledge in statistics, data interpretation, and applications, assessing their awareness of national, regional, and provincial statistical trends and PSA's official releases. Questions also included practical applications of statistical concepts and analytical methods.
