





BASIC SERVICES





SERVICE LEVEL OF TOILET FACILITY BASIC - Sanitation facility designed to hygienically separate excreta 82.6 from human contact, not shared with other households. LIMITED - Sanitation facility designed to hygienically separate excreta from human contact, shared with other households UNIMPROVED - Pit latrines without a slab or platform, hanging latrines or bucket latrines. OPEN DEFECATION - Disposal of human feces in fields, forests, bushes, open bodies of water, beaches and other open spaces or with solid waste. 5.5 4.8 Basic Limited Unimproved Open Defecation






HOUSEHOLD FOOD SECURITY



CBMS measures the household's level of food insecurity to aid Local Government Units in crafting programs and plans that addresses the concern. Questions have varying levels to which the household experiences it from 01 July 2021 to 30 June 2022, provided that it is mainly due to lack of money or other resources.
